Who are R. Locke & Son?

R. Locke & Son are a family-owned independent funeral directors with offices in Brailes, Kineton and Wellesbourne. Led by Colin and Christine Locke and their son George Locke, the team are proud to offer a dedicated and compassionate service. We are members of SAIF, The National Society of Allied and Independent Funeral Directors. As a SAIF member, you can be assured of a compassionate, professional approach, underpinned by an industry-leading Code of Practice.

How much does a funeral cost?

Over the following pages you will find a guide to many aspects of funeral care including different types of funeral and levels of service we can offer. Each funeral is unique and can be tailored to meet your needs and we are on hand to discuss any queries and guide you through each stage of the process. R. Locke & Son will provide a written estimate for your approval of all of our funeral services.

When do I have to pay?

R. Locke & Son's full and simple funeral services can be reduced by £50 if a deposit of 50% of the total estimate or 100% of the third party cost (whichever is greater), is paid before the funeral takes place. The final account will be sent the week following the funeral and can be reduced by a further £50 if paid within 2 weeks. Any outstanding accounts must be paid within 30 days of the funeral to avoid being charged interest. R. Locke & Son's direct services must be paid 3 working days in advance. Full details can be found in our Terms of Business.

What is a Direct Funeral?

A Direct Funeral is a simple, low-cost cremation or burial with no formal ceremony. Most crematoria only allow the funeral director to attend, whereas a small gathering may witness

a direct burial. These services are conducted with all the respect and care that we afford all the funeral services we conduct.

What is the difference between R. Locke & Son's simple and full service?

Our full services are comprehensive, offering traditional or modern funerals including one of our funeral directors in formal dress, a team of up to six pallbearers, modern Jaguar hearse and use of our chapel of rest to visit your loved one. For a more modest ceremony, our simple services allow for one of our funeral directors, in a suit, to be assisted by three pallbearers and a hearsette (estate car or Vito) instead of a hearse. Both services are flexible and can be adjusted to suit your individual needs.

What are the funeral director's services?

Funeral director's services are those elements of a funeral that we provide, and for which the charges are within our control.

What are third party costs?

Third party costs are funeral costs that we traditionally pay on our client's behalf. They can include the charges of cemeteries and crematoria, the fees of clergy or officiants and the costs of newspaper notices and memorials.

Online announcements and donations

We offer an online funeral announcements and donations collection service with the facility to add 'Gift Aid'. We cover all transaction fees to ensure every penny donated goes to the chosen charity.

Bereavement care

SAIF Care allows us to provide clients with exclusive access to a free bereavement care helpline and an online chat service, both of which are staffed by trained bereavement specialists.

DIY funerals - We welcome enquiries regarding DIY funeral arrangements and support for service of thanksgiving. Charges will be according to individual requirements and must be paid in advance. Rates listed are for services only and certain services will incur personnel costs in addition e.g. hearse/limousine hire. Any professional advice will also be chargeable in addition at a mutually agreed rate.

To bear coffins safely and with dignity we use a sliding scale to determine the appropriate number of pallbearers. With a conducting funeral director, coffins up to 90kg require 4 pallbearers. 90kg-135kg require 6 pallbearers. In excess of 135kg require 6/8 or more pallbearers and/or on wheeled bier. Other environment considerations may also effect the appropriate number of pallbearers, all of which are at our discretion. Additional required bearers are at extra cost.
